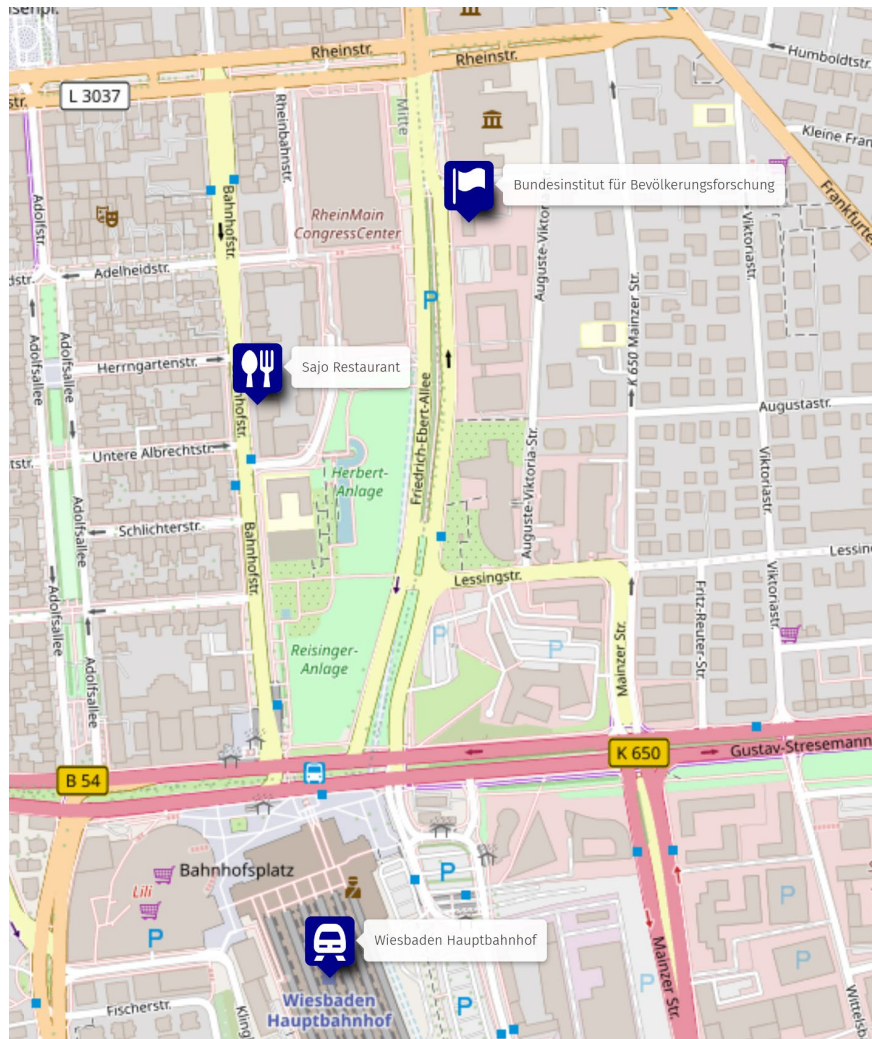
## WORKSHOP PROGRAM
